## Scribe Adapter for Microsoft Dynamics AX

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<b>Version</b>	1.2
<b>Release Date</b>	December 22, 2011

### Requirements

- ▶ Scribe Insight 7.5 or later
- ▶ Microsoft Dynamics AX 4 Sp2 or Microsoft Dynamics AX 5
- ▶ "AX Business Connector user" license per concurrent Microsoft Dynamics AX connection. NOTE: This concurrent connection license is not part of Scribe's User Counting licensing.



If you are upgrading from a previous version of the Scribe AX Adapter, be sure to read the section on Upgrades at the end of this document.

### What's new in version 1.2

#### Features

This version of the adapter represents a technical alignment with Scribe Insight 7.5.

### Requirements

ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsAXServer.msi requires that you have Microsoft .Net Framework 4 Full installed. The .NET Framework can be downloaded from Microsoft or installed from the Scribe Insight Setup folder.



**Note:** If .NET 4 is not available on your computer, then Insight automatically launches an installer to install the **Client** version of .NET 4. However, to install the ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsAXServer.msi correctly, you must install the **Full** version of .NET 4.

If your site is configured such that the AOS resides on a separate server from the .NET Business Connector, you must specify a user name and password when connecting. If you try to connect with the "Use current user credentials" flag checked, you will receive a logon error. For more information, see the following KB article:

## Fixes

<b>Ticket Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
35282,35315	Timeout exception in multithread environment. Scribe bridge fail during connection to Axapta with timeout exception after several hundred records has processed incessantly.
38905, 42704	Source connection fails to AX db with Danish_Norwegian_CI_AS collation.
40007,39412	Resolved the issue where the Scribe AxServerHost must be run on AOS box otherwise the user will receive a "Connection with the Application Object Server could not be established." error when attempting to connect.
39727	Runtime error when processing 33500 records from a text file into AX

## Known issues

<b>Case Number</b>	<b>Description</b>
	When using Microsoft Dynamics AX as a source, the Source Row Number will be incorrect. See OpenMind forum entry <a href="https://openmind.scribesoftware.com/topics/1036">https://openmind.scribesoftware.com/topics/1036</a> for more information.
	You may have to change the login user for the AxService to be a local administrator. Once the service has logged in the first time, it can be changed back to the default user. See OpenMind forum entry <a href="https://openmind.scribesoftware.com/topics/1405">https://openmind.scribesoftware.com/topics/1405</a> for more information.

## Upgrade considerations

Be aware of the following when upgrading the Scribe Adapter for Dynamics AX from version 1.1 or earlier:

- Changes were made to the ScribeAXAdapter.xpo file to resolve D3742 - Source connection fails to AX db with Danish\_Norwegian\_CI\_AS collation. After you upgrade to Insight 7.5, you will need to re-import the ScribeAXAdapter.xpo.

**Note:** If your site is using the Dynamics AX to Dynamics CRM template, you will need to import both the Scribe Adapter for Dynamics AX v1.2 xpo and then reimport the ScribeTemplates.xpo that ships with the template.

- If you are upgrading from v1.0.1 or earlier releases of this Adapter, be sure to reconnect any AX connections to make use of the Windows service added in v1.1. Prior to v1.1, connections were handled via an IIS web service.
- Some systems may require that you reboot after installing the ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsAXServer.msi . For more information, see the following KB article: <https://openmind.scribesoftware.com/topics/2347>.
