Scribe Adapter for Microsoft Dynamics AX

Requirements

- ▶ Scribe Insight 7.6.2 or later
- ▶ Microsoft Dynamics AX 4 Sp2 or Microsoft Dynamics AX 5
- ▶ "AX Business Connector user" license per concurrent Microsoft Dynamics AX connection. This license is not part of Scribe's User Counting licenScribeTemplates.xpo that ships with the template.
- ▶ ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsAXServer.msi requires that Microsoft .Net Framework 4 Full is installed. Download .NET Framework from Microsoft or install it from the Scribe Insight Setup folder.



Note: If .NET 4 is not available on your computer, then Insight automatically launches an installer to install the **Client** version of .NET 4. To correctly install the ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsAXServer.msi, you must install the **Full** version of .NET 4.

- ▶ If your site is configured with the AOS residing on a separate server from the .NET Business Connector, you must specify a user name and password when connecting. If you try to connect with the "Use current user credentials" flag selected, you will receive a logon error. What's new in version 1.2.1.1

Features

This version of the adapter represents a technical alignment with Scribe **Error! Unknown document property name.** This alignment includes:

- Support for Windows Server 2012 Data Center and Standard Editions (x64).
- Ability to install and run Insight and all adapters in UAC-enabled configurations.



For this release, you must upgrade both the Adapter and Scribe Insight. **If you are not planning to upgrade the Adapter, do not upgrade Insight.**



You must be logged into a user account with local administrator privileges to install this adapter.

	When using Microsoft Dynamics AX as a source, the Source Row Number will be incorrect. See OpenMind forum entry "Source Row Number" does not return correct row # for more information.
	You may have to change the login user for the AxService to be a local administrator. Once the service has logged in the first time, it can be changed back to the default user. See OpenMind forum entry After installing the Scribe Adapter for AX v 1.1, my Scribe AXServiceHost service will not start. for more information.

Upgrade considerations

- If your site is using the Dynamics AX to Dynamics CRM template, you must both import the Scribe Adapter for Dynamics AX v1.2.1 xpo and reimport the ScribeTemplates.xpo that ships with the template.
- If you are upgrading from v1.0.1 or earlier releases of this Adapter, be sure to reconnect any AX connections to make use of the Windows service added in v1.1. Prior to v1.1, connections were handled via an IIS web service.
- Some systems may require that you reboot after installing the ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsAXServer.msi . For more information, see the following KB article: <https://openmind.scribesoftware.com/topics/2347>.
