## Scribe Adapter for Web Services

### Requirements

- ▶ Scribe Insight 7.9.0 or later
- ▶ Microsoft .NET 4.0 Framework Extended
- ▶ You must be logged into a user account with local administrator privileges to install this adapter

### What's new in Version 1.5.3

#### Features

This version of the adapter represents a technical alignment with Scribe Insight 7.9.0.



For this release, you must upgrade both the Adapter and Scribe Insight. **If you are not planning to upgrade the Adapter, do not upgrade Insight.**

#### Upgrade Considerations

If you are upgrading from a previous release of the Scribe Adapter for Web Services, you must revalidate any existing web service connections after upgrading.

## Fixes

Case #	Description
41088	D4353: Error when filtering on filter_Field – Invalid data type for field filter_Field.
58633	D8659: Web Service not processing result from method correctly.
66991	D9455: Error raised by a method exposed by UNIT4 SOAP Web Services.
69959	D9771: Error when configuring WebServices as the source – No valid methods were found.
70840	D9807: Inputting an XML string into a Web Service field causes error – Object of type 'system.string' cannot be converted to type 'system.xml.xmlelement'
-	D2466/2464: User name and password in SOAP header are not authenticating.
-	D8722: Error – Unable to cast object of type System.Xml.Schema.XmlSchemaInclude to System.Xml.Schema.XmlSchemaImport.
-	D9117: Cannot assign a different company to each AX service call using AXWebService with the /TA command line parameter.
-	If you have updated the DTS files for this release following the directions in the “do you want to apply these same changes” message, and you open a DTS file in the same directory, the message redisplay. Click <b>No</b> and ignore the message
-	When importing .spkz files containing a web service connection, modifications around custom exception handling, default values and so on, are not imported. This issue will be considered for a future release.
-	Apostrophes are not allowed in the Display Name in the Create Web Service dialog. This item will be considered for a future release.

## Adapter Limitations

When using the Adapter for Web Services, be aware that:

- Web Service connections are established using either the `basicHttpBinding` or the `wsHttpBinding` protocol. `WS_*` and other protocols are not supported.
- This adapter has been tested against a wide variety of web services. However, you may find issues specific to your web service. If you have issues that you can't resolve, please contact Scribe Technical Support.
- In a DTS step configuration, you cannot execute the same method more than once on any given entity.

## Known issues

Case #	Description
50209	D7138: Scribe UI not showing certain fields contained in WSDL.
61287	D8950: Error when trying to validate WSDL: Out of memory.
