Requirements

- Scribe Insight 7.9.1 or later
- Microsoft .NET 4.0 Framework Extended



If the system you are connecting to requires a TLS 1.2 connection, you must install .NET 4.5.2 or later. Some Windows Operating Systems do not support TLS 1.1 or 1.2. See this [Microsoft Blog post](#) for additional information: [Support For SSL/TLS Protocols On Windows](#).

- You must be logged into a user account with local administrator privileges to install this adapter

Scribe recommends using the Adapter for Web Services to connect to Microsoft Dynamics AX 2012 and higher.

What's new in Version 1.5.4

Features

This version of the adapter represents a technical alignment with Scribe Insight 7.9.1.



You must upgrade this Adapter and Scribe Insight. **If you are not planning to upgrade the Adapter, do not upgrade Insight.**

Upgrade considerations

After upgrading from a previous release of the Scribe Adapter for Web Services, revalidate any existing web service connections.

Fixes

Case #	Description
76693	D7482: Processing a DTS did not retrieve the correct values after connecting to a web service and setting SOAP header parameters.

Adapter Limitations

When using the Adapter for Web Services, be aware that:

- Web Service connections are established using either the `basicHttpBinding` or the `wsHttpBinding` protocol. `WS_*` and other protocols are not supported.
- This adapter has been tested against a wide variety of web services. However, you may find issues specific to your web service. If you have issues that you can't resolve, please contact Scribe Technical Support.
- In a DTS step configuration, you cannot execute the same method more than once on any given entity.

Known issues

Case #	Description
50209	D7138: Scribe UI not showing certain fields contained in WSDL.
61287	D8950: Error when trying to validate WSDL: Out of memory.
