Requirements

- Scribe Insight 7.9.3 or later
- Microsoft .NET 4.0 Framework Extended
- If the system you are connecting to requires a TLS 1.2 connection, you must install .NET 4.5.2 or later. Some Windows Operating Systems do not support TLS 1.1 or 1.2. See this Microsoft Blog post for additional information: <u>Support For SSL/TLS Protocols On Windows</u>.
 - You must be logged into a user account with local administrator privileges to install this adapter

Scribe recommends using the Adapter for Web Services to connect to Microsoft Dynamics AX 2012 and higher.

What's New In Version 1.5.5

Features

This version of the adapter represents a technical alignment with Scribe Insight 7.9.3.

You must upgrade this Adapter and Scribe Insight. If you are not planning to upgrade the Adapter, do not upgrade Insight.

Upgrade Considerations

After upgrading from a previous release of the Scribe Adapter for Web Services, revalidate any existing web service connections.

Fixes

Case #	Description
81967	D20783: When the name of one of the connection parameters was the same as the name of the service, the following error was generated:
	Error 896 - startIndex cannot be larger than length of string. Parameter name: startIndex.
82024	D27608: Complex object fields for "model" and "quote" were not displaying as mappable fields on the Activities child insert step.
83808	D23998: When trying to add a new connection using the WSDL below, validation failed. http://tccrmdev.tennis.com.au/TCServices.svc?wsdl
84502	D25413: Made SimpleType arrays work the same way asComplexType arrays to prevent issues with both processing records multiple times or only being able to read the first record.

Adapter Limitations

When using the Adapter for Web Services, be aware that:

- Web Service connections are established using either the basicHttpBinding or the wsHttpBinding protocol. WS_*and other protocols are not supported.
- This adapter has been tested against a wide variety of web services. However, you may find issues specific to your web service. If you have issues that you can't resolve, please contact Scribe Technical Support.
- In a DTS step configuration, you cannot execute the same method more than once on any given entity.

Known Issues

Ca	ase #	Description
50	0209	D7138: Scribe UI not showing certain fields contained in WSDL.
6	1287	D8950: Error when trying to validate WSDL: Out of memory.
