## Scribe Adapter for Microsoft Dynamics NAV

<b>Release Date</b>	March 2, 2012

### Requirements

- ▶ Scribe Insight 7.5 or later
- ▶ Microsoft Dynamics NAV version 6.0/2009 R2, 6.0/2009 SP1, 6.0/2009, 5.0, 5.0 Service Pack 1, or 4.0 Service Pack 3.
- ▶ A dedicated NAS license for each company to be integrated.



Your site may need to upgrade the Microsoft Dynamics NAV client license to support the Scribe NAV Granule. To do so, contact your regional Microsoft AOC and request that the Microsoft Dynamics NAV client license be upgraded to include granule ID: 14094210 titled "Scribe NAV Adapter."



If you are using integration templates provided by Scribe, always check to verify that your template is compatible with this updated adapter. You can verify this information by reading the release notes for your template. You can also check release information in OpenMind for up-to-date information.

### What's new in version 1.7

#### Features

Version 1.7 of the Scribe Adapter for Microsoft Dynamics NAV fixes a number of defects and:

- Provides support for NAV version 6.0/2009 R2.
- Updates the Dynamics NAV codeunits that are provided with the Dynamics NAV fob.

Insight Unicode features are not supported for the Adapter for Dynamics NAV.

## Requirements

The ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsNAV-NAS.msi requires that you have Microsoft .Net Framework 4 Full installed. The .NET Framework can be downloaded from Microsoft or installed from the Scribe Insight Setup folder.



**Note:** If .NET 4 is not available on your computer, then Insight automatically launches an installer to install the **Client** version of .NET 4. However, to install the ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsNAV-NAS.msi correctly, you must install the **Full** version of .NET 4.

If the computer does not have the correct version of Microsoft Dynamics NAV and the NAV-NAS installed, the adapter will not work. It is up to you to verify that the computer on which you are installing the adapter has a supported version of Microsoft Dynamics NAV installed on it. Supported versions of Microsoft Dynamics NAV are listed above in the Requirements section of this document.

## Upgrade Considerations

For the Scribe Adapter for Dynamics NAV version 1.7, a new fob is available for Dynamics NAV version 6.0/2009 R2. In addition, there have been changes to the common .fob.

To upgrade to v1.7, Scribe suggests that you import all .fobs. Be aware, however, that if you have customized any .fobs, you will need to redo the changes after importing. For more information, see Adapter for Dynamics NAV Help file under the section *Implementing the Adapter>Importing the Scribe .fobs*.

If you are upgrading from version 1.4 or earlier of the Scribe Adapter for Microsoft Dynamics NAV, see the Reference topic *Upgrade checklist* in the online help for the Adapter for Dynamics NAV for changes you will need to make.

Previous versions of the Scribe Adapter for Microsoft Dynamics NAV used connection pooling with C/Front connections. Beginning with version 1.5, C/Front is no longer used, and the Scribe.NavAdapter.NavCFrontHostPooler.exe process was removed as part of the upgrade process. However, if this process is still running, the installer cannot remove it and the upgrade will fail. Check the Task Manager to ensure that Scribe.NavAdapter.NavCFrontHostPooler.exe is not running before you upgrade this adapter.
