Scribe Adapter For Microsoft Dynamics NAV

Version 2.0.1
Release Date June 2, 2015



- The Scribe Adapter for Dynamics NAV version 2.0.1 is only supported for Microsoft Dynamics NAV 2013 **R2** and Microsoft Dynamics NAV 2015. If your site is running an earlier version of Dynamics NAV, **do not upgrade** your Scribe software.
- If you are upgrading to Dynamics NAV 2.0.1, you must also upgrade to Scribe Insight 7.9.0. **If you are not upgrading to Dynamics NAV 2.0.1, do not upgrade to Insight 7.9.0.**

Requirements

- Scribe Insight 7.9.0 or later
- Microsoft Dynamics NAV version 2013 R2 or 2015.
- Microsoft .Net Framework 4.5.1 Full

Download this version from Microsoft to enable proper functioning of the NAV Publisher and to run any of the following msi files:

- ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsNAV2013_R2_2015
- ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsNAV2013_R2_NAS_Service
- ScribeAdapterForMicrosoftDynamicsNAV2015NAS_Service
- If you are using integration templates provided by Scribe, verify in the template release notes, that your template is compatible with this updated adapter.



This adapter is a NAS services application. For each NAS services application, Microsoft recommends creating a separate Microsoft Dynamics NAV 2013 R2 or 2015 Server instance. Scribe recommends assigning a unique Dynamics NAV 2013 R2 or 2015 user as the Login account of the Windows service associated with the Server Instance to ensure the audit logging features properly track records modified by Scribe and all requested changes are published.

What's New In Version 2.0.1

This version of the adapter represents a technical alignment with Scribe Insight 7.9.0 and provides support for Dynamics NAV 2013 R2 or 2015.

Only these versions of Dynamics are supported with v2.0.1.



- The Dynamics NAV 2013 credential type of Access Control Service is not supported.
- You must be logged into a user account with local administrator privileges to install this adapter.

Upgrade Considerations



- The Scribe Adapter for Dynamics NAV versions 2.0.1 is only supported for Microsoft Dynamics 2013 **R2** or 2015. If your site is running an earlier version of Dynamics NAV, **do not upgrade** your Scribe software.
- If your site needs to upgrade the Microsoft Dynamics NAV client license to support the Scribe NAV Granule, contact your regional Microsoft AOC and request the Microsoft Dynamics NAV client license be upgraded to include granule ID: 14094210 titled "Scribe NAV Adapter."

Resolved Issues

Case #	Description
64445	D9884: Changing codeunit 1 as documented caused the following error when enabling or modifying the Change Log Setup in NAV: The Change Log Table does not exist.
67660	D9791: When the Sales Invoice was entered, the DTS calculated the Payment Due Date based on the System Date, instead of the Document date. Payment Terms code values were not being mapped by the DTS.
67632	D9465: Error reported that the Description field length is 47 but needs to be less than 30.

Known Issues

Case #	Description
59282	D9341: Boolean fields in XML Publisher messages are set to 0, even when they are set to True in the NAV application.
NA	D9422: Datetime or decimal filters on publisher messages must use the following formats: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Decimal format = X,XXX.XX Date/time format = MM/DD/YY
NA	D7111, D7018: Setting a custom query that filters on a field not in a selected output field causes an object reference error. Workaround: Add the filter field to the list of selected output fields.
NA	D7089: Saving a schema file as UTF8 or UTF 16 saves the file as ANSI. Selecting this as an xml schema file in the Workbench causes the following error: The schema file could not be opened. Switch from current encoding to specified encoding is not supported. Workaround: Open the schema file in Notepad or WordPad and save as a Unicode file.
NA	D7091: Because the following database table names contain an ampersand (&), publishing on them is not supported: Sales & Receivables Setup, Purchases & Payables Setup.
NA	D6964: Using the following ASCII characters followed by another character in passwords is not supported: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> less than (<) ampersand (&) single quote (') double quote (") semicolon (;)
NA	D7141: The Dynamics NAV adapter displays times in UTC when viewed in the workbench.

- Records with double quotes (") in the key field are not processed by the Scribe Publisher for Dynamics NAV and cause the following error in the PubFailed queue: Exception from HRESULT: 0x80004046A.
- Records that double quotes (") in a source filter field or in a lookup field cause the following error: Invalid formula syntax.
